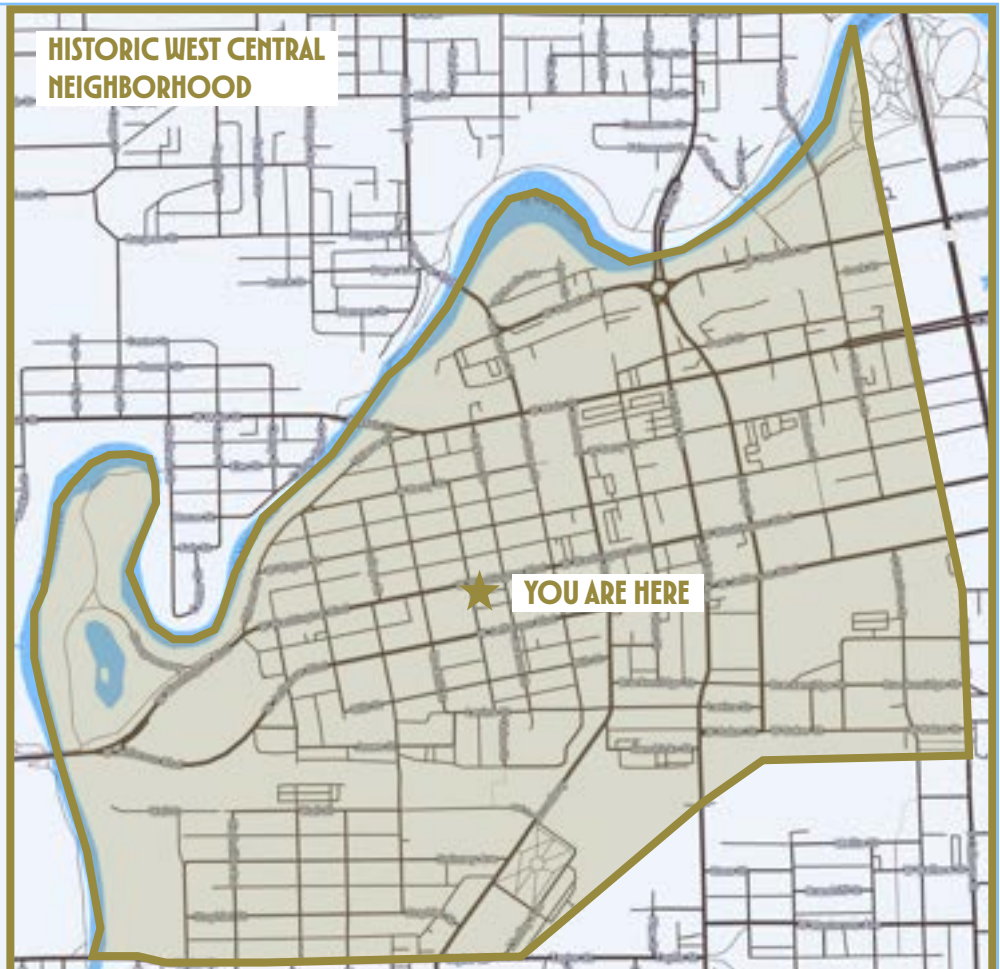
West Central Neighborhood

Ryan's picks:

- **JK O'Donnell's**

JK's is an authentic Irish restaurant and bar. 15-min walk. Paid street parking on Wayne St (eastbound one-way). Open all day Tue-Sat. \$\$

- **Cindy's Diner**

Cindy's is a typical American diner restaurant, but it only seats about 15 people at a time! 15-min walk. Paid street parking on Berry St (westbound one-way). Open 6a-2p weekdays. \$

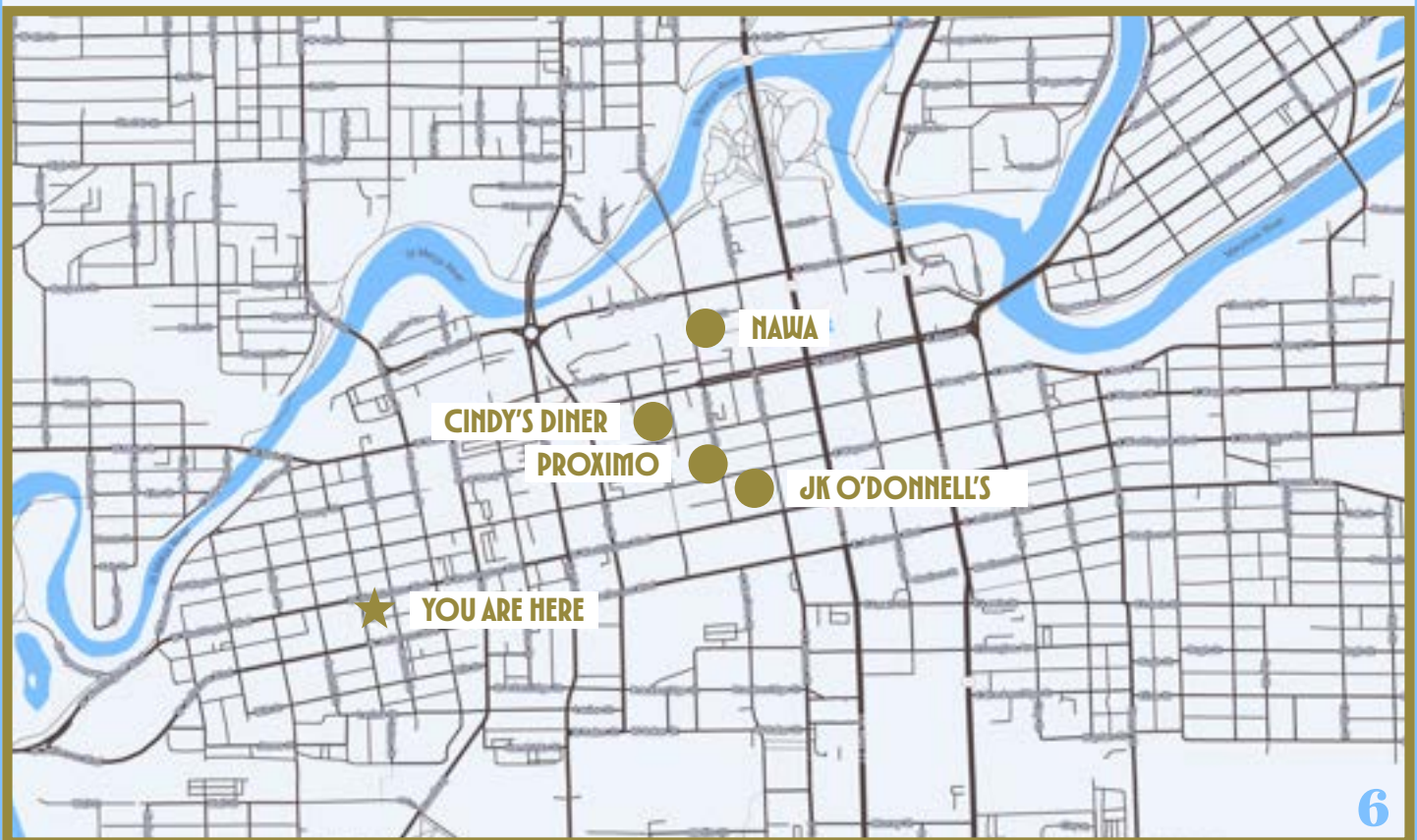
Kendall's picks:

Nawa is an Asian fusion restaurant located at The Landing. 15-min walk. Paid street parking on Harrison St. Open for lunch and dinner daily. \$\$

- **Proximo**

Proximo is a latin-inspired restaurant. 15-min walk. Paid street parking on Harrison St; free one-hour parking in Skyline Garage. Open all day every day. \$\$\$

Things to Do, Places to Be

There are many activities to choose from in downtown Fort Wayne and beyond. In the summer, catch a minor league baseball game with the TinCaps at downtown's **Parkview Field**, and in the winter, go to a Komets hockey game at the **Allen County War Memorial Coliseum** outside downtown.

If sports ain't your style, you could also visit the vast array of arts centers around town, including the stunning **Embassy Theatre**, regional **Civic Theatre**, the **Fort Wayne Museum of Art**, or the **Arena Dinner Theatre** here in West Central.

There are also plenty of opportunities for small business shopping downtown. In West Central, you'll find **Sharon's Victorian House of Gifts** and **Friends of the Third World**. On The Landing, there's **Summit City Vintage**, **Urban Hippie**, and **Blue Bottle Shop**. Scattered throughout downtown, there's **The Find**, **Stoner's Funstores**, **Poptique**, and the **Visit Fort Wayne** store for some local merch.

Otherwise, you could also visit the Foellinger-Freimann **Botanical Conservatory**, the **History Center**, the **Allen County Public Library**, **Electric Works**, **Science Central**, the **Fort Wayne Zoo**, or go to an event at the **Grand Wayne Convention Center**.

You'll also find many beautiful parks around, like **Swinney Park**, **Moody Park**, and award-winning **Promenade Park** right on the river.

On Saturdays, the **YLNI Farmer's Market** is in town from 9a-1p. In the summer, it is located at the intersection of Barr St and Berry St, and in the winter, it is found indoors at 1501 E Berry St.
